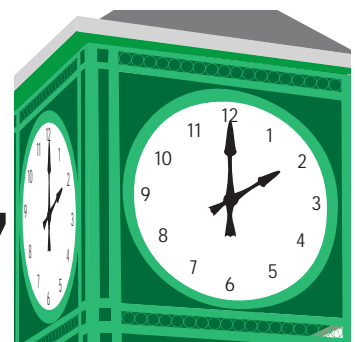

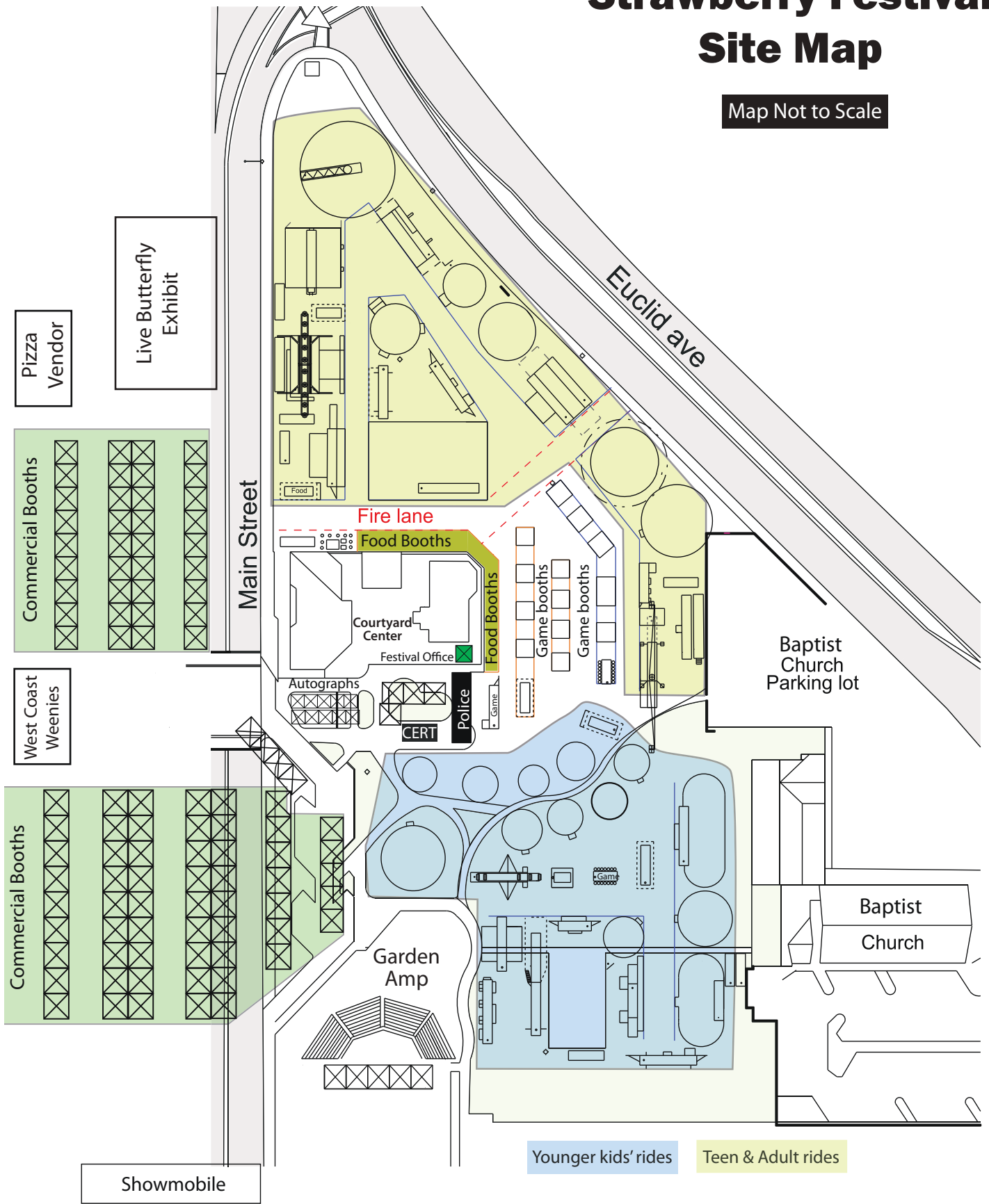

Ed Lee is responsible for the expansion and development of the iconic brand. With more than 35 years of experience in the restaurant and hospitality industry, he has helped establish Wahoo's as a pop culture mainstay. Forging partnerships with brands like Quiksilver, Billabong, Hurley and Vans, Ed has ensured Wahoo's brand presence at high-profile surf, sporting and music events. Ed serves on the board of various non-profit organizations including Share Our Strength, California Restaurant Association and Vocational Visions. In 2018, Ed was named One of OC's Most Influential by the Orange County Register.

Mingo Lee, the youngest of the three brothers, serves as CEO of Wahoo's Fish Taco. With more than 30 years of experience in every aspect of the family restaurant business, he wears many hats, successfully overseeing the company's finances, marketing and day-to-day operations. Mingo is often invited to speak and guest lecture at top universities such as University of California, Los Angeles, University of Southern California and University of California, Irvine, etc. A philanthropist at heart, Mingo supports many organizations such as the Children's Hunger Fund, Humane Society, World Wildlife Fund and Doctors Without Borders.

Scott and his family reside in Garden Grove where he has a creative coaching business and his wife, Teka, is a realtor. Together they have 2 daughters, who are 4th generation Klopfenstein's. Additionally, his sister-in-law, Stephanie, is a Garden Grove City Councilwoman and is running for Mayor.

In Memory of Howard Whittaker

The Garden Grove Strawberry Festival Association is proud to honor the memory of a local Garden Grove Hometown Volunteer, the late Howard Whittaker.

Howard was born in Canada. He later moved to Oregon and enlisted in the US Marine Corps where he served 4 years as an aircraft and helicopter mechanic.

Howard moved to Garden Grove in 1957, met his wife, Mary Jane, and married her later that year. Together they raised 8 children and collectively, they have 22 grandchildren, 46 great-grandchildren, and 18 great-great-grandchildren.



Howard and his wife ran several successful businesses and even secured a patent for a vertical V-shaped metal trellis support device for supporting grape plants to allow for maximum sunlight exposure through efficiently managed canopies.

Howard was a patriotic man who loved his country. He was a generous businessman, loved helping others, and has volunteered with many organizations throughout his life. Most notably, he has been a Garden Grove Elk for the past 60 years.

In 2023, Howard was chosen as the Garden Grove Senior King for his volunteer work in the Garden Grove community and was honored at the annual Garden Grove Strawberry Ball.

As we celebrate our hometown this Memorial Day weekend, we remember and celebrate this generous soul, who will be remembered as a kind, generous man who loved his family, friends, and his community.

The Clock Tower on the Village Green



The Tower on the Green is a project of the Garden Grove Community Foundation (GGCF), a not for profit organization, whose mission is to make Garden Grove a better place to live, learn and play. The Garden Grove Community Foundation programs aim to create a positive image for our city and enhance the quality of life for our community through cultural and educational programs.

The concept for the Tower on the Green was developed in January 1999, to complement the completion of the Main Street Brick Walkway. Under

the leadership of then GGCF President, Harry J. Krebs, a group of dedicated citizens formed the Clock & Brick Committee. This group, which included architects and civic leaders, began planning the design for the clock tower.

In March 1999, the GGCF held a ground-breaking event to raise awareness and excitement about the project at what was then the future site of the Tower on the Green in Village Green Park. At the fundraising event, the first pledges were made by a small but active group of Garden Grove businesses, service clubs, and private individuals. The enthusiasm for the new landmark grew rapidly. One year after the groundbreaking, more than

\$25,000 was raised for the project; by the end of 2001, that number rose to \$118,000 in donations and pledges!

Green Giant Construction Company was selected to build the clock tower and in January 2002 construction began. Two months later, the 30,000-pound main steel structure was delivered and set in place.

The clock mechanism was ordered in November 2001 for delivery in late March 2002. Twin, 4,300 pound, black granite obelisks were ordered and shipped from India to be placed at the base of the Tower on the Green. One obelisk is dedicated to the business community, the other to individual donors.

On April 18, 2002, the Garden Grove community

gathered together to mark the official dedication of the Tower on the Green. The program focused on Garden Grove's rich ethnic diversity, culminating in the traditional ribbon-cutting ceremony and release of 100 white doves.

Architect: Miles Folsom - Anaheim, CA

Tower Dimensions: Height - 43 feet; Width - 12 feet; Weight - 30,000 pounds

Clock Face: The Tower includes four, 700-pound clock faces, each eight feet in diameter. A single control box operates the clock mechanism with a GPS system
